

**PLASTIC** - Any plastic bottle or container with the numbers, “**1,2,4,5, & 7**” are recyclable. Please rinse and remove all lids. Plastic lids with no number go in the trash. Metal lids go with the metal. **Straws, Styrofoam, spaghetti wrappers, motor oil jugs, GROCERY BAGS and etc. are not recyclable.**

**GLASS** - All clear, **FOOD** container bottles and jars are to be clean and placed in tub marked “glass”. **BROWN AND GREEN** glass needs to be placed separate from the clear glass.

**NEWSPAPER** - Newspaper and everything that comes with it can be placed in the same container marked “newspaper”.

**MAGAZINES** - Magazines and catalogs with shiny pages may be placed in any type of bag and placed on top of your recycling cart. **DO NOT PLACE WITH NEWSPAPER.**

**JUNK MAIL** - All junk mail, phone books and miscellaneous papers must be kept separate from newspaper and magazines.

**WHITE PAPER** - Computer paper, plain white paper and school papers may be placed in any type of bag and placed on top of your cart. Must be separate from newspaper, magazines and junk mail. **SHREDDED PAPER** maybe placed in separate bag on top of your cart.

**METAL** - Aluminum foil, tin cans, and pie tins must be clean and in tub marked “tin”. Aerosol cans that are completely empty are also recyclable.

**CORRUGATED CARDBOARD/CHIPBOARD** - Pizza boxes, cake mix, cereal, shoe boxes, cracker boxes, storage boxes and etc. are all recyclable. Flatten and sit on top of your cart to be taken. Cardboard boxes with wax on the outside of them are to be placed in the trash.

**MOTOR OIL** - Must be placed in a container that is spill proof. Please get a sticker from City Hall. \$.50 per gallon to pick up / \$.25 to bring Recycling Center.
